



Crossing and Finishing #2 (Combination Play to score)

The player on the end line dribbles and passes to the central player. The central player then passes out to a wide player and makes an overlapping run. The wide player dribbles inside and then makes a reverse pass to the overlapping player. The overlapping player crosses the ball into the wide player. The wide player attempts to score.

For the next attack, the end line player becomes the new central player. The central player takes the place of the wide player. The wide player rest and wait for their next turn.



Progression

The only change is that the first player now plays a second role in the attack. After passing to the central player, the first player must now get ready to play a wall pass.

When the wide player receives the ball he now plays into the first player and then gets into the box. The first player passes one-touch into space for the overlapping player to run and cross.

The rotation of players is the same as the previous practice.
